

# Support for Facilities Ministry

## Mission

The Facilities Team serves to keep the building and grounds in good repair. The team does minor repairs and maintenance such as patching and painting, hanging pictures and fixtures, moving partitions and general maintenance. The team also does longer-term planning of facility upkeep.

## Projects

An assortment of projects we have completed include extending the stage in the Worship Center, building a frame for and hanging the Easter banner, facilitating upkeep and maintenance of the facility and capital improvements. People serve based on current needs and availability, e.g. Saturday mornings, weekday evenings. Some members of the Facilities Team are retired and work mostly on weekdays.

## Special Skills

We contract out the janitorial services, carpet cleaning, window cleaning, lawn care, and mechanical maintenance. We often rely on people in the church that have expertise in construction, plumbing, and electrical work. In addition, we gather groups for special projects, e.g. yard cleanup, painting, spring cleaning, 'spiffing-up' before holidays or special events.

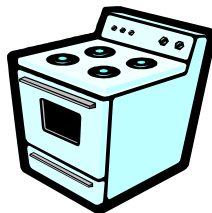
