

Community of ChristChurch Classified Page Policy October 2020

Community of ChristChurch offers a classified page on its website as a service 1) primarily to our church members and regular attenders 2) to the community.

Community of ChristChurch (CCC) shall have no responsibility for the accuracy or reliability of the information set forth herein and no liability whatsoever arising out of the use by anyone of this service. Everyone using this service agrees to these terms by such use. Community of ChristChurch reserves the right to refuse or limit any submissions. This policy may be adjusted and updated as the classified page evolves.

Sales/event postings:

- Preference will be given to CCC members and regular attenders.
- Preference will be given to classifieds that CCC believes will appeal to the largest number of people in our community.
- No personal soliciting for romantic/relational reasons will be accepted or posted.
- CCC will not knowingly accept any advertising which is illegal, fraudulent or in bad taste.
- CCC will not accept advertising for political campaigns, alcohol, cannabis, tobacco, illegal drugs or weapons of any kind.
- Ads which promote fundraising campaigns or solicit funds will not be accepted. If a poster would like to raise funds, they will need to contact the church council via email (cccouncil@googlegroups.com).
- Again, CCC reserves the right to refuse, limit or edit any submissions.

Logistics:

- Listings will be submitted via a form on our website.
- Staff will review the postings as they are submitted. If staff has concerns or hesitations over a posting, they will forward it to the church council executive team for their input.
- When a classified is approved and posted to the classified page, the classified will run for maximum of 3 weeks.
- Re-listings of the same item will not be accepted within the next 2 months of the date of the final listing.
- The exception to the 3 weeks maximum and the re-posting rule is postings for services. Service postings (such as accountants, yard maintenance, etc.) may run for 90 days, and then need to be re-submitted. This ensures an accurate list and engagement with the community but does not place an undue burden on the poster.
- When an item being listed in a post is no longer available, the submitter of the post should notify CCC immediately to remove the post.
- A single individual can only post 2 classifieds at any given time.
- The classified page will be linked to in Faith News and as appropriate the church Facebook page.
