Suze will follow up with Rich Radford requesting a quote for insuring the balance.

Pastor's Health Insurance

Council discussed pastor's employee annual healthcare insurance plan renewal. Selection of employee healthcare insurance plan renewal for annual enrollment purposes.

Mark Henderson made the motion:

Community of ChristChurch council moves to renew the offering of employee healthcare benefits via Portico Benefits Services at the Silver+ C coverage level for the 2022 calendar year.

Steve Delamater seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Committees:

1. Worship Transition Team

- Saturday morning coffee meetups now include masks.
- A sub-group has not had a chance to visit hybrid worship options yet.

- Pastor David has been talking with Rev. Terry Moe on his hybrid worship explorations.
 - Hillsboro United Methodist recently installed an advanced UV light air filter in their building. Discussion on how to look at different air filter systems: HEPA vs. UV system, etc. Jane Jackson & Beth Habecker will research and investigate clean room technology.
 - Does this team work on where we land when we can meet in person? Charter was reviewed. Further discussion is required.
2. Mission and Vision Team
- Suze circulated the current draft. Council accepted the draft with gratitude, inquired about adding the whole welcome statement to a piece of it.
 - Suze will have a breakout room after church on September 12th inviting people to review the current draft. Meeting announcement will run in Faith News on September 9, 2021.
3. Other committees and topics:
- RIC: The next step once you have the designation is education. This includes reading and deeper understanding. Another component will be reaching out to LGBTQ+ communities directly and share stories.
 - Youth dialogue: Engage with parents and youth.
